The City of Jeffers will participate in the Urban Tree Program this spring sponsored by Cottonwood Soil and Water District. The city will spend \$400 and CSWD will match \$400 giving the city \$800 to spend on purchasing trees. The city plans to purchase ten trees at a cost of \$80/tree. The trees will be planted at the Ball field and other areas to be determined. Three city residents who signed up last summer, will also have the chance to purchase trees through the program.




Do not burn if it is windy.

Mychael Swan, Agrinatural Gas, LLC, is planning to hold a community meeting in May to hear from the residents of

Jeffers on how interested you are in bringing natural gas to Jeffers. According to Swan, a resident who burns fuel oil and pays approximately \$3.60/gallon, is actually paying \$5.04/ gallon because of the inefficiency of the furnace. Fuel oil is only 50 to 80% efficient depending on the age of the furnace. Natural gas is 92% to 96% efficient and is less than 1/3 of the cost. For those that use propane, the savings can be as much as 40%. The cost of converting can be paid for in as little as 2 years.
